RE: Amendment to the Developmental Disabilities Waiver (DDW) and Fee Schedule

The State of New Mexico Human Services Department (HSD) through the Medical Assistance Division (MAD) is accepting written and recorded comments for a period of 30 calendar days ending at **5:00 p.m. Mountain Time (MT) Monday, June 29, 2020** regarding the Developmental Disabilities 1915 (c) Home and Community-Based Services (HCBS) Waiver amendment and proposed fee schedule.

The State intends to submit this amendment to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) in July 2020.

The key components of proposed changes under this amendment are as follows:

1. Update the developmental disabilities eligibility definition from a categorical to a functional eligibility criterion. The State found that national best practice is to utilize a "functional" criterion that is based on adaptive abilities. Updates were made to Appendix B-1-b.

Impact: HSD does not anticipate a service or financial impact to participants currently receiving services. HSD anticipates a positive impact to applicants who may be eligible for services under the functional definition of developmental disabilities.

2. Implement a rate increase, effective October 1, 2020 for Case Management, Supported Employment, Customized Community Support, Crisis Supports, Supported Living, Intensive Medical Living Services, Nutritional Counseling, Preliminary Risk Screening and Consultation for Inappropriate Sexual Behavior, and Respite. Updates were made to Appendix I-2 a and J-2-d(i).

Impact: HSD anticipates a positive financial impact to DDW service providers.
